Pashupatinath temple construction begins, embarks fulfillment of a solemn promise

4 December 2015, Indore: Work for construction of the pashupatinath temple, Shri Sarveshwar Mahadev Temple, and a care home for children with special needs at Tillor Khurd began today in full swing with ritualistic worship and prayers being offered before the laying of the foundation stone.

The beginning of this construction embarks the fulfillment of a solemn promise by Shri Manoj Thakkar, author of the acclaimed spiritual novel Kashi Marnanmukti, of dedicating all sale proceeds from his book towards a charitable cause. The book released in 2010 and went on to be a great success. The inspiration at first was to start a care home for children with special needs with the money, that inspiration later combined with another greater inspiration of building a Shiva temple along with as well. In time a lot more people joined and supported him in his endeavour, which has today begun to take shape.

In May earlier this year, amidst a large gathering and the venerable presence of saints from throughout the country, the Boomipujan ceremony was held with the Almighty's blessings at the site of the temple and the care home at Tillor Khurd where the construction has now begun. Shiv Om Sai Trust, a registered charitable trust, is building the aforesaid works.

The temple being built will be like the Pashupatinath Temple at Kathmandu, from its Architecture to the other temples of Goddess Mother Annapurna, Vasukinath, Lord Hanuman, Lord Unmat Bhairav and Lord Lal Ganesha that will also be built in the temple complex like in Kathmandu. The temple complex will cover an area of 25,000 sq ft with the main temple consisting of approx. 5500 sq ft, the care home will cover an area of 40,000 sq ft, while the total campus shall be spread over an area of 3 acres.
